TITLE: Feminine Masculinity MEDIUM: Colored pencil and sharpie on paper DIMENSIONS: 14 x 17 cm DATE COMPLETED: October 2019 I was inspired by the acrylic print by Pedro Tapa called 'choose your own path' in order to create my pieces detailed designs surrounding the male figure in order to relate to humans relationships with the earth and the environment, and how connected we become when we are aware of our intertwining relationship with the Earth.
